

Minutes for the January 11th, 2006 Pima County 4-H Shooting Sports Leaders Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m., in the County Extension Office conference room, by the director. Probable changes will be that the University will no longer own any shooting equipment and the addition of an equipment handling and storage module to the Shooting Sports training curriculum.
