Minutes for the February 14th, 2007 Pima County 4-H Shooting Sports Leaders Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the County Extension Office conference room by the coordinator. Eleven leaders were in attendance: George Boone, Phil Davis, Dennis Eskridge, Don Heins, Stephen Heins, Suzanne Heins, Tracy Nielsen, Briggs Todd, Alice Whiteside, John Whiteside and Laurel Whiteside. No Guests attended the meeting. Curt Peters, County Extension Agent, attended.

The minutes from the January 14th, 2007 meeting were approved as presented.

The treasurer's report indicating a balance of \$776.15 was approved.

Curt Peters: reported that the planning for the State Shooting contest was underway.

All old and new business items on the agenda were discussed.

The following decisions were agreed upon unanimously:

- To approve the change to the Pima County Archery rules to show one point awarded per ethical pass taken.
- To establish that the designated range masters for the Pima County Fair 4-H Shooting Sports Matches have total authority over their range.
- Shooting scores will not be penalized for safety infractions.
- That the maximum size limits for posters will be strictly observed.

Other items discussed:

- The Dog Project radios were found to be in need of battery replacement. Other sources of radios have been found.
- The shooter's safety instructions were reviewed. Changes to the archery and shotgun instructions were discussed.
- Safety judges will be recruited from the 4-H adults.
- An archery qualification match to establish the 4 members of the recurve archery team will be held on March 24th. The FITA section of the National Invitational match will be the course of fire.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
